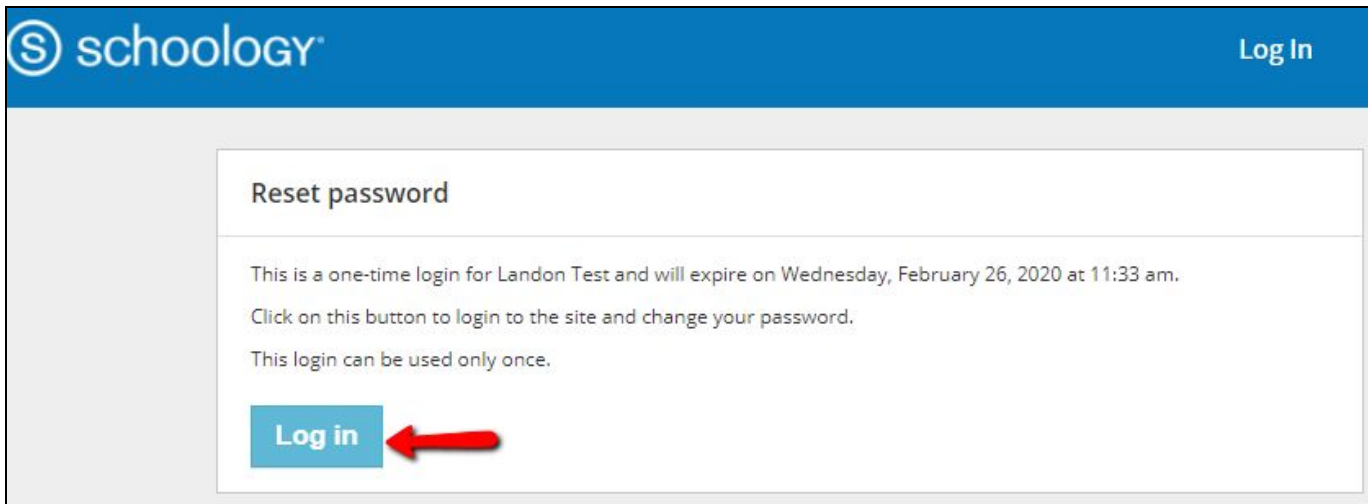


4. Enter a new password of your choice twice and then click Submit.

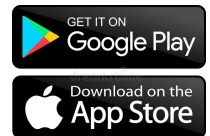

Schoology Mobile App - Highly Recommended for Parents

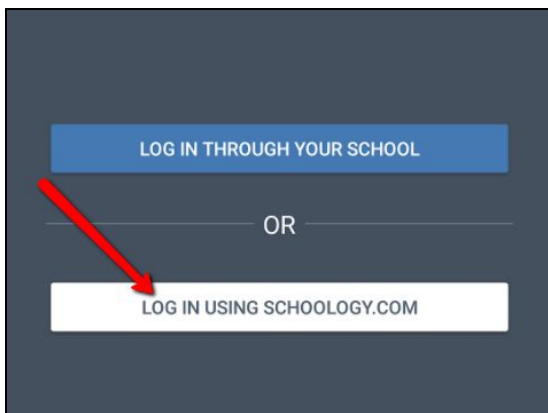
