Remote Learning will finally begin for students tomorrow, April 7th. Teachers are very excited to engage with students again!

Students, remember that engaging in the remote learning is important for you to earn credit for your 4th Quarter classes. You cannot hurt your grades. The only thing you can do is improve, by engaging and making an attempt. Teachers are all on your side in this and are going to work with you to make sure that you progress. Please make sure that you login to Schoology Tuesday - Friday, and get started on your lessons.

Students may work at any time of the day that they can (unless a teacher is holding a live conference during their class time). Please check each class in Schoology to determine if you need to be on at the designated class time, or if you can work on the assignment at any time. Most assignments will be open to students working on them as they can, with expected due dates according to each teacher. Teachers are being mindful not to overlap on due dates and have spread them out to support students. There might be some issues with Schoology in the morning. Sometimes it is getting overloaded with all of the nation-wide use of it. If that is the case, try again in the afternoon or evening. Don't get frustrated, just give it some time. Stop Germs! Wash Your Hands.

When?

- After using the bathroom
- Before, during, and after preparing food
- Before eating food
- Before and after caring for someone at home who is sick with vomiting or diarrhea
- After changing diapers or cleaning up a child who has used the toilet
- After blowing your nose, coughing, or sneezing
- After touching an animal, animal feed, or animal waste
- After handling pet food or pet treats
- After touching garbage



How?



Wet your hands with clean, running water (warm or cold), turn off the tap, and apply soap.



Lather your hands by rubbing them together with the soap. Be sure to lather the backs of your hands, between your fingers, and under your nails.



Scrub your hands for at least 20 seconds. Need a timer? Hum the "Happy Birthday" song from beginning to end twice.



Rinse hands well under clean, running water.



Dry hands using a clean towel or air dry them.

Keeping hands clean is one of the most important things we can do to stop the spread of germs and stay healthy.
