During regular registration: <i>Register students at their school of attendance.</i></li> <li>• <b>Late registration will be one day only on Thursday, June 6, 2019.</b> During late registration: <b>Register students at the Administration Office, 10665 Jimmy Camp Road, Fountain.</b> Hours of operation are 7:30 a.m. - 3:30 p.m. If you miss the late registration, you will need to register your child on the first day of summer school, June 17, 2019, at the school they will attend.</li> <li>• A 25% deposit will be required at the time of registration. The deposit will be applied toward the cost of classes.
