As we enter into the 4th quarter of school, we sense the urgency and the importance of every school day. Student attendance is critical during the last two months of the school year. Grades 3 – 5 will be participating in state testing throughout the month of April. Each classroom has a specific testing schedule. Your classroom teacher has the specific schedule. Please schedule any appointments outside of the testing calendar as it is very difficult for us to complete make up assessments.

Many grades have field trips planned for this quarter. All field trip volunteers and chaperones must be preapproved by the classroom teacher. Additionally, all chaperones are required to come to the school and have a visitor badge created for the trip. The opportunities to chaperone may be limited by the number of seats available, the requirements of the field trip host and the needs of the classroom.
